



## SNOWPLOWING AGREEMENT 2017-2018 SEASON

This contract is for the 2017-2018 snowplowing season starting with the first snowfall through March 31, 2018 and is not cancelable at any time during the snowplowing season. You are responsible for the full season payment of this contract. Eastside Landscaping will provide plowing markers (blue-tipped stakes) for your driveway. We will collect them after the snowplowing season ends, so please leave them visible for collection.

Your driveway will be plowed when the snowfall accumulates 2" or more. Eastside Landscaping will make every reasonable effort to plow driveways by 7 a.m. **IF THE SNOW FALLS EARLY ENOUGH OVERNIGHT TO DO SO.** If we get daytime snow, we will make every effort to plow driveways by 6 p.m. **IF THE SNOW FALLS EARLY ENOUGH IN THE DAY TO DO SO.** Plowing schedules are directly affected by the amount and rate of snowfall, the timing of the snowfall and traffic conditions. During whiteout conditions and heavy snowfalls, the amount of time to completely plow through a route *once* could easily double or triple from the average time of 4-5 hours. Please realize that when any of these conditions occur it requires extra time, so please be patient. Your driveway will be plowed as soon as possible.

As a courtesy to our clients, we offer two payment plan options. We offer a **FIVE-DOLLAR DISCOUNT OFF THE ENTIRE SEASON PRICE IF FULL SEASON PAYMENT IS RECEIVED BY NOVEMBER 1, 2016.** If you do not pay in full, you will be billed for two payments. First payment is due no later than November 1, 2017. You will receive a bill for the second payment which is due January 1, 2018. Any overdue account is subject to a 2 percent per month service charge and/or suspension of service until payment in full is received.

Eastside Landscaping is **NOT** responsible for chipping/cracking of concrete or asphalt, broken or lost drain covers, sprinkler heads/lines, driveway lights, buried pipes/wires/posts, grass damage, lost newspapers. We are also not responsible for basketball poles, garbage cans, garden hoses, outdoor toys or any other removable objects and these items should be removed from your driveway before the plowing season begins. If snow falls from your roof and blocks your garage or driveway, there may be an extra charge to remove this snow. If property damage occurs, damage must be reported to our office no later than May 15, 2018. Most repairs can be done by Eastside Landscaping. If a company other than Eastside is required to do repairs, any and all repair estimates must be approved by Eastside or will not be reimbursed. We are not responsible for any personal injury occurring in your driveway, sidewalk or apron at any time.
